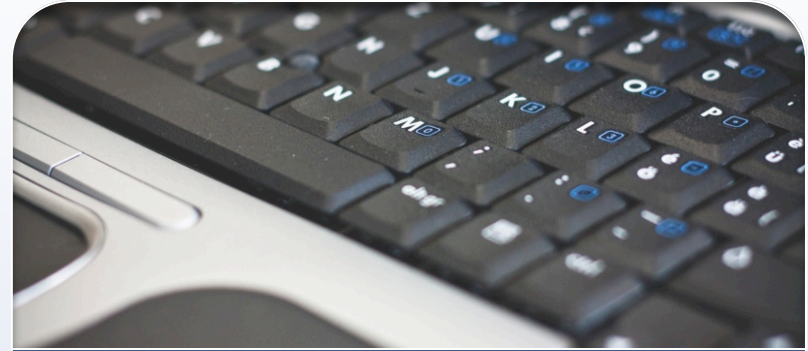

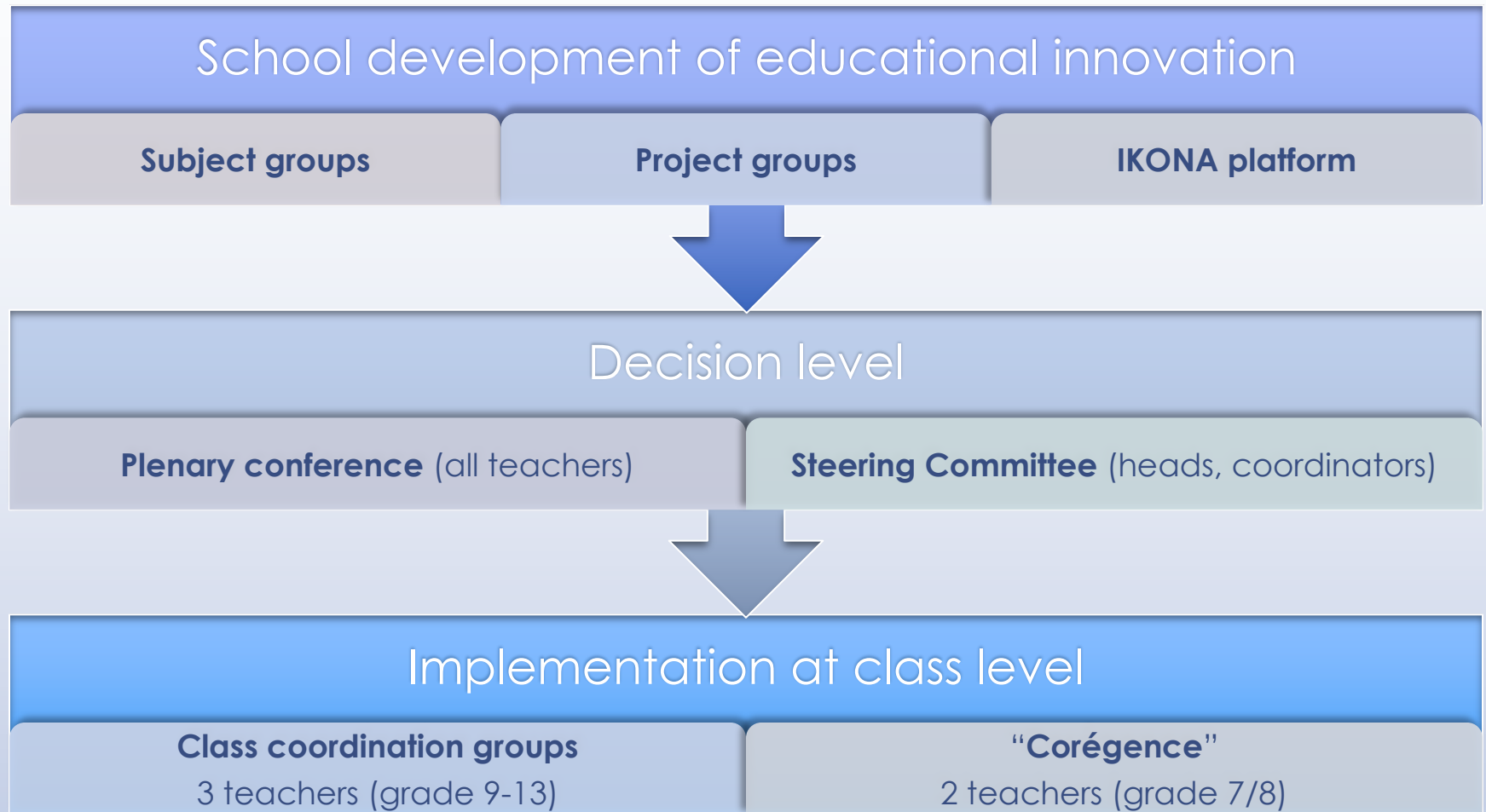

Grade 7 Individual challenges for grade 7

Key innovation

- Getting the students to work on their own

Shared core aims

- To encourage pro-active approach to learning
- Do develop the student's autonomy

The concept

- Teachers give the students only support regarding infrastructure, material and link them up with other facilitators
- At the end: a “graduation” ceremony together with parents; diploma given by the principal

The outcomes

- The students learn to overcome hurdles
- An improved relationship between teachers and students
- An increase of self confidence (Yes, I can 😊)
- The student is held accountable for managing his own project
- Skills such as using PowerPoint, speaking in front of an audience,... are trained
